A well respected, prominent Houston attorney, Thomas A. Vaughn, originally founded Tavaero Jet Charter. Mr. Vaughn purchased his first Learjet 25 series in 1995 and envisioned providing exceptional service with exceptional equipment. This vision started Tavaero Jet Charter.

Houston businesses and prominent Houstonians recognized quality and commitment and Tavaero grew quickly to include a fleet of Lears, Westwinds and Hawkers. Unfortunately in 1999 Mr. Vaughn was diagnosed with cancer and he passed away. His family... who did not share his enthusiasm for aviation sold the company to Renato Venturini and Marcela White who were already associated with Tavaero precisely because of their years of experience in charter, their dedication to the industry and their desire to have Tavaero Jet Charter continue Mr. Vaughn's legacy.

For the next few years Tavaero Jet Charter focused on quality of service and safety. Growth has always been important however never at the expense of safety and personal contact with our customers. Our size has always worked to our advantage.... every employee has instant access to upper management and every employee is empowered to make suggestions and decisions for the company. Our TEAM spirit provides little room for job descriptions, as every employee at every level is required to do the job to make each flight a success.

In 2000 we added our first heavy aircraft, a Challenger 601 that worked well with our existing fleet and clientele. Between 2004 and 2009 we added more Hawkers and another Challenger. We also added our very first state of the art turboprop...an Avanti Piaggio II. Our current fleet is comprised of 3 Challengers, 3 Hawkers, 2 Westwinds and the Piaggio II. We provide a full complement of aircraft for every travel profile for our customers.

In 2010 we have refined our focus to concentrate less on the fleet and more on the operation. Our fleet accommodates existing clientele with the need to travel domestically, to Canada and/or North and South America and Europe. Customers and operators alike would like to have the ability to use our fleet for their more extended travel requirements. After a two month process of working with the FAA we are proud to announce that Tavaero Jet Charter has been approved for worldwide operations.

What was once a single airplane, single pilot operation has grown into a highly respected charter operation within our industry and among the businesses in Houston, Texas. We look forward to competing in the international arenas and will undoubtedly succeed as a result of our TEAM philosophy and outstanding group of employees.
